SC20016 - Digital Social Value Platform:

The details we require are:

- * Suppliers who applied for inclusion on each framework/contract and were successful & not successful at the PQQ & ITT stages
- * Actual spend on this contract/framework (and any sub lots), from the start of the contract to the current date
- * Start date & duration of framework
- * Is there an extension clause in the framework(s)/contract(s) and, if so, the duration of the extension?
- * Has a decision been made yet on whether the framework(s)/contract(s) are being either extended or renewed?
- * Who is the senior officer (outside of procurement) responsible for this contract?

The procurement process is still in progress and as such we are unable to disclose the information requested as it is not currently available. Once awarded, the contract details will be added to Contracts Finder, as well as the Contracts Register on the Kent Business Portal.

If you are unhappy with this response, and believe KCC has not complied with legislation, you have 40 working days from the date of this response to ask for a review.
