I am writing to confirm that the University has now completed its search for the information which you requested on 14 July 2010.

Our disability policy ensures that any person with a declared disability will be offered an interview for any advertised position, assuming the person meets the essential criteria of the position. Since 1 January 2010, 88 candidates for employment have declared a disability. Of those, 21 met the essential criteria for the position for which they were applying, and were offered an interview.
