Dear Mr Kilker

I am writing in response to your request for a review received on 20 July 2016.

You originally asked for:

Any documents relating to the implementation of DYL line alterations on Hethersett Road, and you'd specifically like to know where the impetus for these additional alterations came from?

The Council's response was:

There have been no amendments to the Traffic Regulation Order for No Waiting At Any Time (double yellow lines) on Hethersett Road since 2010 when the wide area review took place. Our highway teams have recently been to this site to refresh the black out lines as the original double yellow lines were beginning to show through near the junction with Derby Road (a stretch of double yellow lines was removed in 2010).

You feel that Gloucestershire County Council (GCC) withheld information in relation to your request about the extension of the blacked out area, and the person requesting that extension. You would like GCC to provide a full and proper response to your FOI request.

I have now completed my investigation and can confirm that you have already been provided with all the information the Council holds on this issue. The lines were blacked out again as the double yellows were beginning to show back through. When this was done the Council cut them back by about 1m, however it did not require an amendment of the Traffic Regulation Order.





I can inform you that the request came from the Gloucester City Councillor - Sajid Patel.
