The Dogs (Fouling of Land) Act 1996 identifies the regulations applying to this Act. It states that a Local Authority: "A local authority may by order designate for the purposes of

such land. this Act any land in their area which is land to which this Act applies; and in this Act "designated land" means land to which this Act applies which is for the time being so designated".

What areas in E14 are not designated, such that the Act has no relevance?

All areas other than all LBTH owned parks, streets and open spaces

Has Tower Hamlets received any application from land owners to exclude them from the Act?

It may be that some areas of land are not be designated, within Tower Hamlets, and not covered by the Act.

What powers then exist for penalties to be applied to a person in charge of a dog, when fouling occurs on private roadways, pavements and estates?
