I write in connection with your request for information which was received by Derbyshire Constabulary on 08/06/2021. I note you seek access to the following information:

*My request concerns police records of domestic abuse in the years 2019, 2020 and 2021. I want the figures, please, for January-May of those years for:*

- 1) *Number of calls to the police reporting an incident of domestic abuse*
- 2) *Number of arrests and charges relating to domestic abuse*
- 3) *Number of prosecutions for domestic abuse*
- 4) *Number of homicides flagged as being related to domestic abuse*
