Do you provide access to an Independent Domestic Abuse Advisor (IDVA)?

No. Access is via a joint funded Police and Council initiative as above.

Do you have a Domestic Abuse policy?

EKHUFT refers to the Kent Domestic Abuse policy and there is a section on domestic abuse in the adult safeguarding policy which signposts staff to the KCC policy.

Domestic abuse is included in the level 2 adult safeguarding training which all patient and public facing staff must have every 3 years. Our trust compliance is 88%. (The national standard is 85%).

We can confirm EKHUFT does not record this data. The data is held by the IDVA or the DA agencies we refer to.
