The Arrest Date was set between 01/01/2012 and 31/12/2012.

The Arrest Offence was set to equal 'Mental Health Act' or 'S.136 Mental Health Act'. (Please note - no arrests were returned for 'S.136 Mental Health Act').

The data in this report is a count of persons arrested and taken into custody.

The data doesn't show if the individual was arrested for an arrestable offence as well as detained under the Mental Health Act.

If someone is detained under section 136 of the mental health act, they are not arrested, and they are taken to a place of safety other than an MPS custody suite, a custody record is never created. These instances will therefore not be included in this report.
