I can confirm that the information requested is not held by Durham County Council. I have detailed below our response.

You requested: Can you tell me how many of the 472 teaching assistants predicted a loss of salary from figures produced in 2017 are still forecasted to lose salary in January 2020?

How many are predicted to lose less than £50?

How many are predicted to lose between £600 and £999

How many are predicted to lose more than £1,000?

Our response: We can confirm per s(1) (1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 that we do not hold the requested information. We cannot at this stage accurately say how many TAs will lose money as there will continue to be many changes to contracts made. However, the overall number of TAs who may lose salary has reduced significantly over the last year.


