Re: Freedom of Information Request

Thank you for your email of 24 October 2017. You made the following requests for information:

1. Please can you advise how many DVPP providers you have in South and West Yorkshire.

In South and West Yorkshire Cafcass currently has two providers who are able to offer programmes covering these areas.

There are also surrounding providers who may also take work from the referring teams in those areas where the participant lives locally to them. Therefore there are also an additional number of participants across the South and West Yorkshire service areas who have been referred by courts in South and West Yorkshire but who will attend courses in other areas.

For questions two and three, Cafcass have only included the numbers applicable to the providers directly working across South and West Yorkshire areas in accordance with the above.

2. How many courses have been provided to date.

Please note Cafcass only holds this information from 2012 onwards as before this we did not collect this information so as to be retrievable electronically. This information is from financial years 2012-13 to 2016-17.
