The Mayor, Chief Executive and various officers of Tower Hamlets Council met with all the key housing associations operating in the borough on 26th June. The Chief Executive of EastendHomes was present at this meeting and the Mayor said that the Council would offer all housing associations, including EastendHomes, any key advice and general support they could to help meet the challenges faced following the Grenfell Tower disaster. This offer of advice and general support has been on-going since the Grenfell Tower disaster happened on 14th June 2017. A joint statement between Eastend Homes and the Council has also been released.

Can you tell me will they be given access to public funds? If so will they have to pay it back?

Local authorities are working with the Department of Communities and Local Government (DCLG) on this matter, however DCLG have not yet made any public funding available.
