Dear Mr Jones,

Thank you for your email of 14 July 2018 which requested the following information:

I understand your decision based on associated costs and ask, as an alternative, that the relevant parts of the revised maintenance/servicing schedules resulting from the 02198 modification be made available.

I am treating your email as a request for information under the Freedom of Information(FOI) Act 2000. A search has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence, and I can confirm that information in the scope of your request is held.

Along with this letter, you will find copies of the relevant sections of the maintenance schedules that were amended following the introduction of modification 02198. This comprises of the Ejection Seat maintenance schedule and the Breech Type Time Delayed Firing Unit maintenance schedule. The highlighted sections of the maintenance instructions indicate those that have changed or been added post modification. Information that is not highlighted was unaffected by the modification.

If you are not satisfied with this response or you wish to complain about any aspect of the handling of your request, then you should contact me in the first instance. If informal resolution is not possible and you are still dissatisfied then you may apply for an independent internal review by contacting the Information Rights Compliance team, Ground Floor, MOD Main Building, Whitehall, SW1A 2HB (e-mail CIO-FOI-IR@mod.uk). Please note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
