Thank you for your email dated 26 November 2018, which requested the following information:

Can you advise me as to the issue date(s) of the Maintenance Procedure 29-10/3 issued.

A search has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence (MOD), and I can confirm that some information in scope of your request is held.

The Ejection Seats for ZD743 were armed and installed using maintenance procedure MP 29-10/3 and the task was completed on 15 March 2011. The latest version of MP 29-10/3, available at this time was AL 33, Trilogiview version 58, dated March 2011. It is standard practice to use the latest version of the MP available, but it cannot be verified that this was the case in this instance.

The Ejection Seats for ZD812 were armed and installed using maintenance procedure MP 29-10/3 and the task was completed on 19 November 2009. The latest version of MP 29-10/3, available at this time was AL 27, Trilogiview version 41, dated November 2009. It is standard practice to use the latest version of the MP available, but it cannot be verified that this was the case in this instance.
