Thank you for your email dated 12 January 2019, which requested the following information:

Tornado ZE 982 crashed in Glen Kinglas, Argyll, Scotland, in 2nd July 2009. Can you advise me as to whether the ejection seats were pre or post mod 02198.

A search has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence (MOD), and I can confirm that information in scope of your request is held.

I can confirm that the seats installed in Tornado ZE982 were post modification 02198.
