Thank you for your request for information that has been processed under reference number

- 1. If the Trust currently has an electronic order communications system, ie a laboratory test ordering system in place?
- a. If so, which system? Yes iCM via CSC
- b. What was the cost of the system at the time of purchase? This was purchased as part of a suite of products/ managed service, so is not identifiable as a separate item.
- c. In which hospitals and in which departments is the system currently in use? All
- d. Has it been implemented for both wards and GPs? Wards at Trust use iCM; GPs use Sunquest ICE to order from Trust Labs.
- e. Does the Trust have a current vendor contract for the software? Yes
- f. If so, when does it expire? Expected to be 2017
- g. Does the Trust have a current support contract for the software? As above
- h. If so, when does it expire? As above
- 2. If the Trust currently also has an electronic Admission, Discharge and Transfer (ADT) system in place? Trust uses Lorenzo to cover PAS ADT functionality. Discharge summaries are done with iCM. Extramed White Boards system is used in conjunction with Lorenzo for transfers/patient flow.
