Freedom of Information request
Brent CCG (Ref: CCG/9111)

Thank you for your Freedom of Information request made to Brent CCG.

You requested the following information:

Sir David Nicholson, then Chief Executive of the NHS in England, requested in a letter on 15/03/2012 that individuals or their representatives notify the relevant PCT in respect of previously un-assessed periods of time where there is evidence that the individual should have been assessed for eligibility for NHS CHC funding with respect to that care.

- 1/. Please let me know how many applications were received by the CCG, and/or the CCGs/PCTs it replaced, before the first deadline Sir David gave in that letter, ie 30/12/2012?*
- 2/. Of those applications received, how many reached the stage of being processed by the CCG, and/or the CCGs/PCTs it replaced?*
- 3/. Of those which reached the stage of being processed by the CCG, and/or the CCGs/PCTs it replaced, how many have so far resulted in a Decision Letter?*
- 4/. Of those which have reached the stage of a Decision Letter, how many applications have been refused?*
- 5/. Of those which have reached the stage of a Decision Letter, how many applications have been refused for reasons relating to original documents or records having been lost or destroyed?*

Our response to your request is:

- 1/. Please let me know how many applications were received by the CCG, and/or the CCGs/PCTs it replaced, before the first deadline Sir David gave in that letter, ie 30/12/2012?:**

Brent CCG (the former Brent Primary Care Trust) received 109 applications.



The North West London Collaboration of Clinical Commissioning Groups is a partnership of eight Clinical Commissioning Groups working to transform the quality of health and social care across North West London. The collaboration includes Brent, Central London, Ealing, Hammersmith and Fulham, Harrow, Hillingdon, Hounslow, and West London Clinical Commissioning Groups.

2/. Of those applications received, how many reached the stage of being processed by the CCG, and/or the CCGs/PCTs it replaced?
Brent CCG discounted 56 cases on the basis of lack of duty, another CCG's responsibility or period already funded.

3/. Of those which reached the stage of being processed by the CCG, and/or the CCGs/PCTs it replaced, how many have so far resulted in a Decision Letter?
Brent CCG provided an outcome letter to all of the 109 cases.

Brent CCG/PCT has communicated the outcomes of the process to all 109 cases.

4/. Of those which have reached the stage of a Decision Letter, how many applications have been refused?
Brent CCG did not refuse any cases; 56 were discounted and 3 which did not have any evidence of eligibility following full consideration.

5/. Of those which have reached the stage of a Decision Letter, how many applications have been refused for reasons relating to original documents or records having been lost or destroyed?
Brent CCG has no claims applications closed or refused on the basis of missing documentation.
