Thank you for your e-mail of 10 April, in which you ask for "a copy of notices issued by the European Operational Policy Team between and including 21 October 2014 and 10 April 2015". Your request has been handled as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

I can confirm that we hold the information you have requested. The Free Movement Operational Policy Team (formerly the European Operational Policy Team) has issued five notices during the period you have specified and I am releasing them to you as Annexes 1-5 to this response. I have summarised details of the notices below:

Names and telephone numbers of individual staff members referred to in the notices have been redacted in accordance with section 40(2) of the Act on the ground this information constitutes personal data. It is Home Office policy not to identify members of staff below senior civil service (SCS) grade. I can confirm that the relevant staff members are all below SCS grade.



Furthermore, in Annexes 3 and 4, I have removed links to the staff intranet, since these links are not accessible outside of the Home Office. However, these documents contain a link to the public version of the same guidance as published on www.gov.uk.
