College Energy Efficiency Pathfinder (CEEP)

I am writing to confirm that the Scottish Funding Council (SFC) is pleased to offer Newbattle Abbey College funding of up to £476,850 for works conducted as part of Scottish Government's College Energy Efficiency Pathfinder (CEEP). This funding will allow Newbattle Abbey College to procure energy efficiency savings through Energy Conservation Measures (ECMs) which will be agreed with and delivered by Amaresco on behalf of Newbattle Abbey College.

The funding will be paid out in academic year 2016-17.

Conditions of funding

This funding is offered in accordance with SFC's Financial Memorandum subject to the requirements of the tender exercise which was concluded in February 2017, the attached requirements for Strategic Funding grants and the following specific conditions:

- All works relating to CEEP will be concluded by 31 August 2017.
- Funding will be used to pay Amaresco to retrofits ECMs agreed with Amaresco and Newbattle Abbey College to the college estate.
- We expect Newbattle Abbey College to report the impact on carbon emissions as part of your Outcome Agreement reporting until 2020. For the purposes of this project SFC will be monitoring from 2018.

Outcomes

We are administering funds on behalf of Scottish Government to support CEEP in the achievement of its key outcomes, which in turn supports the delivery of our Strategic Outcomes on

- Outcome 1: High quality teaching and learning (access to learning, success in learning, progression from learning)
- Outcome 3: Greater innovation in the economy (national strategy and practice, strategic investment, enterprise and creativity, international)

The outcome of this funding is that Newbattle Abbey College will achieve a reduction in carbon emissions and accrue Energy Savings which can be reinvested into its estate.

Monitoring and evaluation

Newbattle Abbey College is required to submit an end of award report which includes a final financial statement, and can do so at any point after 31st January 2019 (Milestone 2), but by 30th September 2019 at the latest. You will also report on how you fulfilled any commitments, resulting in improvements or mitigation, set out in your Equality Impact Assessment for this programme of works.
