What this means for claimants

Claimants can now undertake permitted work for less than 16 hours each week and earn up to £120 every week after tax. There is no limit on the number of weeks you can do permitted work for.

What happens next

You don't have to contact Jobcentre Plus unless there have been any changes to the work you are already doing.

Please tell us about any changes

It's important that you tell us **straightaway** about any changes that could change the amount of benefit you get. For example, you need to tell us if:-

- you have a new health condition, or your existing health condition gets worse
- your health condition gets better
- there is a change to your, or your partner's, income or savings.
