Our response to your request

SFC has participated in two ESF programmes to date:

- 2007-13 ESF programme (covering delivery in annual years 2010-11, 2011-12, 2012-13, 2013-14 and 2014-15)
- 2014-20 ESF programme (covering delivery in annual years 2015-16 onwards)

For the 2007-13 ESF programme please refer to the attached spreadsheet which details the funding received from Scottish Government for this programme.

In terms of the 2014-20 ESF programme, SFC has not reclaimed any ESF monies from the Scottish Government for ESF activity delivered by the sector under the current 2014-20 ESF programme (i.e. since the start of 2015-16).
