FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST

Thank you for your request for information received on 13 January about EU academic staff.

The University's response is provided below.

Some time ago, I wrote to you about the difficulties of recruiting academic staff from the EU in the current political climate. I am concerned, but hopeful that UWE has been able to continue to recruit EU staff in significant numbers.

I was wondering if you would be able to tell me:

1) How many new EU academic staff the university has been able to recruit over the last year

[Between the 16th January 2019 and 15th January 2020, 43 EU Nationals started in Academic roles at UWE.](#)

2) How many EU academic staff have left the university over the same time period

[30 EU academic staff left the University in 2018-19.](#)

3) The overall number of EU academic staff currently working at UWE (this one is less important)

[The number of EU academic staff employed as academics in the University in 2018-19 was 177.](#)

[Please note that we have more up-to-date data available in relation to joiners which is why the reference period for leavers and joiners is slightly different.](#)
