Why do you promote yourself as a court of law, when all evidence presented is hearsay?

Please see below for our response.

Cafcass does not promote itself or describe itself as a court of law. Cafcass is a non-departmental public body accountable to Lucy Frazer MP, Secretary of State at the Ministry of Justice. Operating within the law set by Parliament (Criminal Justice and Court Services Act 2000) and under the rules and directions of the family courts, we are independent of the courts, social services, education and health authorities and all similar agencies.

Cafcass operates within the law set by Parliament and under the rules and directions of the family courts. Our role is to:

- Safeguard and promote the welfare of children
- Give advice to the family courts
- Make provision for children to be represented
- Provide information, advice and support to children and their families
