Dear Daniel F,

Thank you for your emails dated 21 April 2018 requesting the histories of 4 vehicles.

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

Guidance from the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) states that a valid request "must be in writing; include the requester's name and an address for correspondence; and, describes the information requested". Your request is considered invalid under section 8(1)(b) of the FOIA as you have not provided your full name (i.e. any variation of your title or first name combined with your surname).

It should be noted, if an invalid request is processed by a Public Authority, the requester would have no recourse to the ICO as their powers only extend to valid requests under section 8 of the Act.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may raise your complaint directly to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not normally investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
