Thank you for your email of 4th November which I can confirm is considered to be a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) 2000. You requested information on the following vehicle:

A search for the information has now been completed and I can confirm that unfortunately no information in scope of your request is held.

Please note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
