### **Freedom of Information Request - RFI20190442**

Thank you for your request to the BBC of 06 March 2019 seeking the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 ('the Act'):

*"I would be grateful if you could provide me with an itemised list of each booking BBC staff have made via One Transport in the past 12 months.*

*The data should include:*

*The charge code used*

*The department associated with the charge code (be specific, e.g. "Today" or "Newshour" not "Radio 4" or "World Service")*

*Whether the booking was for a BBC staff member or for their guest*

*The date and time the booking was made*

*The date and time of the journey*

*The origin postcode - or the full address if a BBC building*

*The destination postcode - or the full address if a BBC building*

*Any additional requests made by the person booking (e.g. black taxi, requests for a particular driver)*

*Any reasons given for out of policy bookings*

*The status of the journey (e.g. completed, no-show, cancelled)*

*The cost of the journey to the BBC"*

The Act does not require us to comply with a request if to do so would exceed the appropriate limit as set out in the Freedom of Information and Data Protection (Appropriate Limit and Fees) Regulations 2004 (SI 2004/3244). The appropriate limit has been set at £450 (equivalent to two and a half days work, at an hourly rate of £25). In order to respond in full to your request we estimate that to carry out this search would take BBC Staff more than two and a half days. Therefore, under section 12 of the Act, we are refusing to handle the request as it would exceed the appropriate limit.

However, you may be interested to know that the BBC proactively publishes the expenses of its most senior managers on a quarterly basis. The information can be found using the following link;
