Freedom of Information Request

I refer to your Freedom of Information Request received on the 25th April 2019. I apologise for the delay in providing the information.

Your request asked for the following information:

Your Request

Can you inform me under the freedom of information act. How many "extra ordinary meetings" have been held for elected members to discuss the outcome of a Local Government Ombudsman's (LGO) report within a week of the LGO issuing its final report? I wish to know the number of meetings for each year since 2010.

Council's Response

Since 2010, one (1) Extraordinary meeting of Borough Council has been convened to discuss a Public Interest Report issued by the Local Government and Social Care Ombudsman (LGSCO).

On 13 February 2018, the LGSCO issued his final Public Interest Report, which made recommendations in respect of a complaint by Mr Y, regarding the process followed during an investigation into his actions, where Mr Y was found to have committed abuse against a vulnerable older person.

In accordance with the Local Government Act 1974, section 31(2), Borough Council were required to consider the Public Interest Report and provide evidence of this to the LGSCO.

On 26 March 2018 the Public Interest Report was presented to an Extraordinary Meeting of Borough Council as required by the above legislation. This was 6 weeks after receipt of the final report.

Since 2010, the Council has received no (zero) other Public Interest Reports by the Local Government Ombudsman (LGO) or Local Government and Social Care Ombudsman (LGSCO).

All such requests must be sent to us within 4 weeks and must clearly state in writing your reference number and your reasons for your request for internal review.
