### **Freedom of Information Request**

Dear Mrs Price,

Thank you for your email of 26 April, in which you asked for the following information from the Ministry of Justice (MoJ):

- *How many court staff have been sacked or charged with falsifying court documents or accepting falsified court documents.*

Your request has been passed to me because I have responsibility for answering requests relating to HR issues.

Your request is being handled under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

Under the Act, the department is required to provide you with a response within 20 working days. I will write to you in response to your request for information by 25 May.

The Freedom of Information Act includes a number of exemptions to releasing information. Some of these are qualified exemptions which require us to consider whether it is in the public interest to disclose or withhold the information. In these circumstances we may need more time to consider your request, and if this is the case I will write to you by the date above to inform you of when you can expect to receive a response.
