Request for Information: Farm Terrace Allotments, Watford

Thank you for your email of 15th April 2013 in which you requested information about the application to the Secretary of State for disposal of Farm Terrace Allotments, Watford.

Your request asked for the following information:

All copies of correspondence and communications between the Department for Communities and Local Government and Watford Borough Council between the 1/2/13 and 15/4/13.

I have considered your request under the terms of the Environmental Information Regulations 2004. I confirm that the Department holds the information that you have requested, and I am able to supply it to you. A copy of the information is enclosed, in the format you requested.

You will also note that I have redacted the names of officials and officers below Senior Civil Servant (SCS) level because (a) we take the view that you are probably not seeking this information, and (b) our view is, in any event, that the information also falls within the exceptions at Regulation 12(3) as defined by Regulation 13(1) and (2)(a) of the Environmental Information Regulations in so far as the disclosure of those names would not be fair and hence would contravene the first data protection principle in the Data Protection Act 1998.
