Request	<p>I write to request for all papers set for each Prize Fellowship examination, to be sent in reverse chronological order beginning 2010, for instance: all papers set for 2010, all papers set for 2009, all papers set for 2008, and so forth.</p> <p>I additionally request for Prize Fellowship translation papers with unseen passages in modern languages, to be sent in reverse chronological order beginning in the last year in which such papers were set.</p> <p>I would be most grateful if you would respond to my second request first, spending six hours or an amount of time necessary to send twelve modern language translation papers, whichever is less, before spending any remaining time up to the 18-hour limit on my first request.</p>

Dear Mr Liauw,

I write in reply to your email requesting the above information.

The College response to the request is as follows:

I am writing to advise that the papers from 2010 onwards are available in digital format on our website at Examination Fellowships, grouped by subject. Copies of earlier papers, including the translation papers of the Modern Languages papers, are available in the College Library. They run to several volumes and we are currently unable to locate copies of the papers for some years. If you wish to visit the Library to consult them, please contact the Library. Please note that, at the moment, the Library is operating a very reduced service owing to the present pandemic restrictions.
