Thank you for your request received on 20 May 2015, for the following information: I would like to know the number of adults and children with disabilities - whether physical disabilities, severe learning difficulties or anything else that is defined as a disability - who have been moved out of borough to cheaper accommodation, whether that be temporary or permanent.

I would like to know the figures for children and adults in aggregate and also separately.

I'd like to know how many people with disabilities who receive housing benefits are being moved out of different London borough because their existing accommodation is no longer affordable.

I'd also like to know how many disabled children whose families receive housing benefits are being moved out of borough because their existing accommodation is no longer affordable

Please could you provide this information for the ten full years from and including 2005 to 2014.

We have processed this request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

## Response

I am writing to inform you that we have searched our records and the information you requested is not held by London Borough of Barnet.

Housing services are provided for the council by Barnet Homes who are an Arm's Length Management Organisation (ALMO) who manage the council's housing stock, homelessness and allocations on our behalf. They are a public authority and subject to the Freedom of Information Act so you may make a FOI request to them.
