### **Request under the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 (FOISA)**

Thank you for your request of 20 May 2021 under the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 (FOISA).

#### Your request

You asked for information about deaths in Scotland between 15 and 16 May 2021.

#### Response to your request

I am writing regarding your request dated 20 May 2021 for information about deaths in Scotland between 15 and 16 May 2021.

A request is not valid if it does not, in accordance with section 8(1)(b) of the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 (FOISA), state the name of the applicant and an address for correspondence. As your request states a pseudonym instead of your actual name we do not consider it to be a valid request. Accordingly, we are not obliged to respond to it.

However, if you provide your name (a surname and title, eg Mr or Ms, is sufficient) we would be able to consider your request and respond in accordance with FOISA.
