B) Names of organisations contracted as delivery partners for each programme identified, the value of each contract, and a copy of each contract

- be provided with that information (subject to any exemptions under the Act which may apply).

We have interpreted this request to be asking for projects/programmes that have involved the Department for Business, Energy & Industrial Strategy spending money or contracting delivery partners. In this case, we do not hold any information as there has not been any programmes in scope.

## **Appeals procedure**
