FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000 - INFORMATION REQUEST

Thank you for your request for information received by the Council on 6th August 2018. It has been assessed and the following information is provided in response:

Can you detail how many fire doors have been installed in properties under your management that have been supplied by the following companies:

Manse Masterdor

Masterdor Limited

Specialist Building Products Limited, trading as Permadoor

Solar Windows Limited

Birtley Group Limited, trading as Bowater by Birtley

We are currently undertaking a review of previous improvement works undertaken (going back many years) because the actual make of the door may not have been recorded.

However, we can confirm that 248 Manse Masterdoors were installed in 2009/10 because this information was provided to us by MHCLG.

We can also confirm that 480 Manse Masterdoors were installed during a refurbishment programme in 2014.

At this stage we are unable to provide any further details.

Have you taken any action to remove fire doors supplied by these companies since the Ministry for Housing, Communities and Local Government announced these five suppliers have now been identified as failing to meet requisite fire performance

standards.

No, we are complying with the advice provided by MHCLG in Advice Note 16 and assessing the risk in liaison with our Fire Risk Assessors as new assessments are undertaken.

Have any doors supplied by these companies been removed before the announcement.

No, Ealing Council has had a fire safety improvement programme in place since July 2016 and we have already replaced over 3,000 front entrance and communal doors as part of that planned programme in our tower blocks and sheltered properties.
