Thank you for your request of 16th April 2020 in which you asked for the following information:

1. The number of fires in the construction industry in 2018/19
2. The number of fires caused by hot works in the construction industry in 2018/19
3. The main causes of hot works incidents in the construction industry
4. The number of injuries and fatalities caused by hot work incidents in the construction industry

We sought clarification on whether the request was for all fires on construction/building sites or just building fires on construction/building sites, which you responded to confirming we should 'include data of any fire on buildings on building/construction sites caused by hot work which is any fire started by welding, cutting, grinding, brazing, or similar flame or spark-producing operations'
