Thank you for your recent request received on 11 June 2019. Your request was actioned under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 in which you requested the following information:-

Who is responsible for the rollout of Five G and when will residents be informed about the rollout and health and safety issues

Response

Liverpool City Council confirms that it holds information relevant to the terms of your request, our response being set out below:-

There is not one person responsible for the roll out of 5G across Liverpool. As with the existing 3 and 4G networks it is expected that all the mobile phone operators will roll out 5G networks across the city. They will have to comply with any relevant planning regulations and people will be informed through that process.

Currently there is a 5G mesh network being developed across Kensington to provide health and social care services – this is not a cellular phone network. The local residents have been informed about the rollout.

Public Health England have stated that the 5G technology is safe and does not provide any extra risk to people.

This concludes our response.
