Co-ordination of immunisation programmes



Specialist input to ICB coordination and oversight of health protection incidents



Safety, improvement and financial balance for medicines



Improving clinical effectiveness and efficiency – lead on system wide clinical policies, medical device and formulary guidance

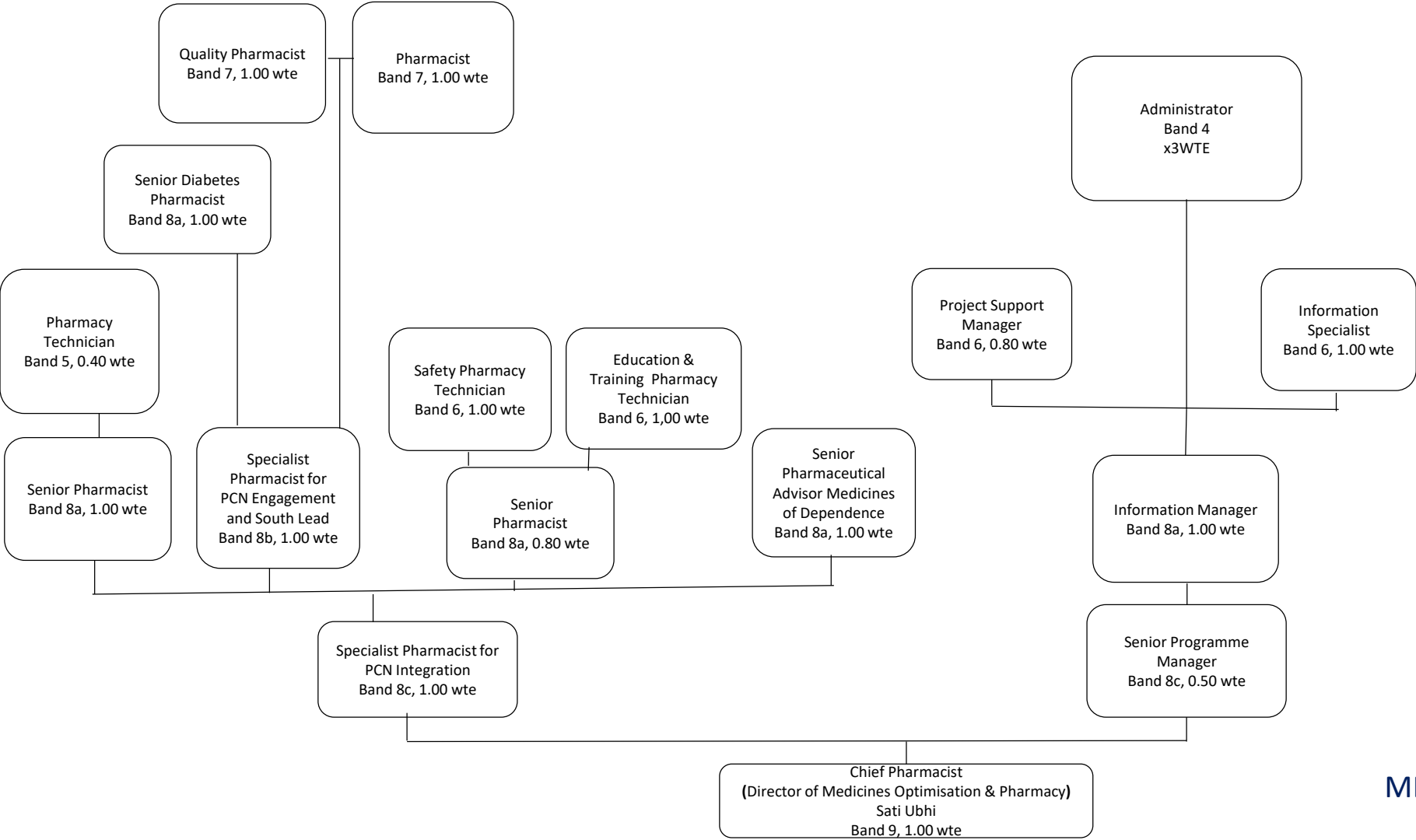
