FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST 62759

Thank you for your e-mail of 22 February 2021, in which you ask:

- 1. How many contingent workers (contractors, temps, freelancers) used from 2010-2020 give breakdown by year?
- 2. What is the annual spend on contingent workers (last financial year)?

Your request has been handled as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

1. I confirm that the Home Office (HO) holds some of the information which you have requested on numbers of contingent workers. However, we believe that the information is already reasonably accessible to you. It can be found at https://www.gov.uk/government/collections/ho-annual-reports-and-accounts.

Section 21(1) of the FOIA exempts the Home Office from having to provide you with this information, because it is already reasonably accessible to you. If you have any difficulties in accessing this information at the source which I have indicated, please contact me again.

Home Office does not hold some of the data requested. Whilst we are required to publish information regarding contingent labour in HO Annual Report and Accounts this has not been achieved consistently across each publication and numbers of contingent workers fluctuate. An extract from each Annual report is provided at Annex A below.

We have reviewed and considered that to provide the requested information in a consistent form across the requested years would only be available at disproportionate cost and s12 of FOIA would apply if attempted. It is likely that information to fuel any attempt may not be available.

2. I confirm that the Home Office holds the information which you have requested on annual spend on contingent workers. However, we believe that the information is already reasonably accessible to you. It can be found at page 89 of the FY 2019/20 annual report https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/home-office-annual-report-and-accounts-2019-to-2020. I have listed the entry as shown below at Annex B.



Section 21(1) of the FOIA exempts the Home Office from having to provide you with this information, because it is already reasonably accessible to you. If you have any difficulties in accessing this information at the source which I have indicated, please contact me again.

If you are dissatisfied with this response you may request an independent internal review of our handling of your request by submitting a complaint within two months to foirequests@homeoffice.gov.uk, quoting reference 62759. If you ask for an internal review, it would be helpful if you could say why you are dissatisfied with the response.

As part of any internal review the Department's handling of your information request would be reassessed by staff who were not involved in providing you with this response. If you were to remain dissatisfied after an internal review, you would have a right of complaint to the Information Commissioner as established by section 50 of the FOIA.
