#### 8(d)1 Missed Collections

Figures produced.

*Domestic* refuse missed collections appear to be levelling out at just above 60. This is still 50% above the BVPI target of 42.

*Green Box* missed collections increased slightly but this was the second lowest figure since the start of the new contract. This is 74% above the BVPI target of 31. *Organic* missed collections at their lowest since the start of the new contract. This is 62% above the BVPI target of 24.

The general trend of improvement continues. It must be remembered that the figures are what has been reported after 2pm. Some of these may be collected later as the recycling crews don't finish until about 3pm to 4pm.

## 8(d)2 Rectification Points

JR produced details of rectification points issued. None were contested. JR reported that last week produced 3091 points. A 5% increase to the previous week. Tables and graphs were produced. There are still problems with algorithms used by Contender that need to be rectified.
