		There then was a discussion concerning the weeds in Brent. However it became apparent that JfM was allowing for low weeds to be graded as good whereas MOB and JR explained that no matter how short the weeds were they were an indication of detritus which would give a poor score.	
		JfM explained that the 1 st traunche was within the targets set by the StreetCare Operation Plan but this was corrected by MOB and JR explaining that the target within the operational plan and identified in the contract was a BV199 score of 19%. The 1 st traunche score was given as a NI195 %age score and when translated to the NI199 score would be about 8% higher. Grade bc in BV199 is scored as 1 failure where in NI195 it is scored as ½ a failure.	
		JfM then stated that if this was the case that he didn't have sufficient	

resources to completely remove all the weeds and grass so there would be no detritus. JFM stated that he had given instructions to his managers that to keep the weeds and grass to about 1cm was acceptable.

It was then agreed to try to meet with TP, IS and CW to resolve this matter on Thursday with our managers and budget holders.

7(c)iv Bins and Boxes

There were no new reports concerning stock etc.

7(d) Missed Collections

JR supplied statistical data with graphical representations. The improvement in missed organics and green boxes was noted although there was a slight glitch in the domestic collections.

7(d)i Domestic Refuse

There were 96 reported missed collections compared to 123 the previous week. This 22% reduction was noted.

7(d)ii Green Box

There were 44 missed green box collections compared to 47 the previous week. The 6% reduction was noted.

7(d)iii Organic

There were 76 missed organic collections compared to 84 the previous week. The 9½% reduction was noted.

7(d)iv Estates

The next estates report is due in October

7(e) Rectification Points

There were a total of 1305 rectification points compared to 1158 the previous week. Many of these were overgrown weed problems (470 points).

7(f) WEEE Collections

Tonnages for 2009 to 2010 are still being difficult to find out. JR will make enquiries with TT later this week.

7(g) IT Up-Dates

JR and MOB told the meeting that there were still problems with the new collection schedules. There is another meeting at StreetCare on Thursday to which both JES and NA were invited to try to understand how the problems originated and then to resolve them.
