Below is an extract from the minutes of a meeting with Veolia on Tuesday 13th July 2010. The contents are self explanatory. Could you assist with this problem please and let me know what can be done so I can report back to the meeting next Tuesday.

“Cricklewood Broadway Trade Waste – 13/7/2010

EB reported that he was on last weekend and visited Cricklewood Broadway at about 7.30am. He reported that there was excessive trade waste between Walm Lane and Chichelle Road and Chichelle Road and Ashford Road. EB reported that the waste was predominantly trade although there may have been about 10% domestic from the flats above the shops. JR agreed to forward this to the Enforcement Team.”

Hi John

We conducted a comprehensive Duty of Care operation in this area from December 2009 through April 2010. All business have been inspected and served statutory notices. We are taking enforcement action against 13 businesses for non compliancy. The general levels of compliancy are high. It might be an idea for the StreetCare officer to monitor this area over a few weeks and report any concerns to us. We have a pro-active project week coming up in mid August and we can pay some attention to the area. It is our experience that a lot of waste dumped is domestic waste from the flats above shops which do not benefit from balcony collections. Part of our current Enforcement review is looking at weekend working patterns with a view to being more pro-active over weekends when a lot of trade waste is dumped. In the meantime if any Veolia personnel find evidence or suspect a particular businesses re dumping they should be encouraged to pass the information to my team who will investigate accordingly.
