- Suppliers who applied for inclusion on each framework/contract and were successful & not successful at the PQQ & ITT stages
- 2. Actual spend on this contract/framework (and any sub lots), from the start of the contract to the current date
- 3. Start date & duration of framework/contract?
- 4. Could you please provide a copy of the service/product specification given to all bidders for when this contract was last advertised?
- 5. Is there an extension clause in the framework(s)/contract(s) and, if so, the duration of the extension?
- 6. Has a decision been made yet on whether the framework(s)/contract(s) are being either extended or renewed?"

Our response

Under section 1 of the Freedom of Information Act, we confirm that we hold the information requested. Please see our response below.

- 1. NHS Property Services (NHSPS) has not advertised this contract. This contract has been subject to direct awards since April 2018.
- 2. Approximately £2.3m has been spent on this contract to date.
- 3. The original contract duration is 12 months commencing in 2017 and it was extended through direct awards for subsequent years.
- 4. As per the response in 1.
- 5. There is no extension clause.
- 6. A decision has not been made regarding the extension or renewal of the contract, however there is a review planned for March 2022.
