At this time of year we are mindful that the weather can suddenly change and that we may at any time have heavy snowfall that could lead to an emergency school closure. Mrs Goldsmith has been updating our emergency school closure procedures for parents and this has been sent to you today as a separate attachment. Please familiarise yourself with our guidance notes as this will help make any evacuation or closure a lot quicker and smoother.

I very much appreciate parents' support in ensuring that the children attend school smartly dressed and in the correct uniform – we also have very clear policies on the wearing of jewellery, nail polish etc. Jewellery must not be worn for reasons of safety – if your child has pierced ears only the smallest of studs should be worn to school but these must be removed for PE lessons by your child or they will not be able to take part in the lesson. I have also noticed a number of pupils wearing nail polish and this should be removed before your child attends school. Thank you for your support; I do regard this as a very important factor in the success of the school.

Healthy School's Policy

We would like to remind parents of our healthy school's policy. We have spoken to the children recently and they all agreed that eating healthily means that they are able to concentrate for longer during lessons. They were told that they may have a piece of fruit as a morning snack, and that drinks bottles should only contain water. The school considers a healthy lunchbox to consist of; a sandwich, wrap or roll, yoghurt, fruit, and if required a small packet of crisps <u>or</u> a plain cake <u>or</u> a plain biscuit. To avoid confusion please <u>do not</u> include chocolate covered items. Pure fruit juice, not squash, is permitted as part of your child's packed lunch.

If your child was born between 1st September 2008 and 31st August 2009 you must apply for a school place by 15th January 2013. You must apply to the borough in which you pay your Council Tax and you will be requested to supply proof of address showing the name of the borough or district and the council tax account number for the property where your child normally lives. If you live in Surrey you can find out all you need to know about school admissions and apply online at: www.surreycc.gov.uk/admissions, or you can telephone Surrey Schools and Childcare Service on 0300 200 1004. You must request a booklet and/or a paper form if you do not wish to apply online,
