I refer to your request where you asked:

'I wish to see the full report(s) of the that details the impact of food shortages in the event of a no-deal Brexit.

The papers allegedly say that: 'UK leaving the EU without a deal would cause a 7 per cent drop in GDP for Ireland. compared to a 5 per cent drop in Britain. This is because Ireland is "a more open economy than the UK. accounting for 60 per cent of GDP comprised of goods imports and exports, as opposed to 40 per cent for Great Britain".'

I am writing to advise you that following a search of our paper and electronic records, I have established that the information you requested is held/not held by the Cabinet Office.'
