Description of route, features, nature of obstructions, notices or direction posts, particulars of stiles and gates, etc.

Starts at junction with the County Road in Llanwada Village, crossing open land to stone steps over bank against pine end of Cottage, and running along the northern edge of first three fields, passing through first fence by fieldgate gap, and the next two fences by stone step stiles. Beyond the third field the path crosses to the other side of the fence, and runs through a field rather overgrown with fern to a low bank obstructed by barbed-wire. It then crosses a small stream and runs through the middle of the field to stone step stile, and crosses the northern end of the next two fields by stone stiles into a fenced lane running south of the farm to join the County Road at Ciliau.

Length .51 miles.

General condition, average width, and reason for believing path to be public.

Well defined path. Several of the stone step stiles are in need of attention. The path through the last field has been built up by large flat stones alongside the hedge bank. The lane has been obstructed by a loose stone bank at its junction with the County Road.
