Hi Lou

Our guidance on crime mapping is attached. This provides an overview of what our concerns are when it comes to identifying the exact location of a crime. I've also attached a recent Decision Notice in relation to Greater Manchester Police. This is a useful DN as GMP outline in their arguments some of the data protection concerns that arise from flagging where a crime has occurred. Even though in this case the ICO's decision was that GMP should disclose (and GMP didn't appeal) it does, I think, outline the main points that we focus on when considering point data mapping for crimes. It may be useful background for Chris.

I'll also have a look through my papers from the Crime Mapper Steering Group which I sit on and if there is anything else which may be of relevance I'll copy it and bring it over.
