## Freedom of Information Request

Dear Selamat Pagi,

Thank you for your email of 27<sup>th</sup> January 2015, in which you asked for the following information from HM Courts and Tribunals Service (HMCTS):

**“Can you please provide me a copy of FTT judgment in the case of  
IA/42048/2014?”**

**If there is any other information relating to this case, which you feel that can be  
released publicly, (IE: Notes of the Hearings etc) I would appreciate it a lot if you

Your request has been passed to me because I have responsibility for answering requests relating to the First-tier Tribunal (Immigration and Asylum Chamber). Your request is being handled under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).
