## **Freedom of Information Act 2000**

I am writing to confirm that the Trust has now completed its search for the information relating to funding for TEACCH in South Eastern Trust which you requested on 10 June 2013.

The South Eastern Health and Social Care Trust has hosted TEACCH training on an annual basis for a number of years.

The full cost of the TEACCH training has been met by the funds generated through the marketing of places to individuals from a variety of organisations, statutory and voluntary across the island of Ireland and further afield, eg England and the Isle of Man.

Training has been provided in South Eastern Health & Social Care for Trust personnel as identified in their appraisals as a recognised training need at no additional cost to South Eastern Health & Social Care Trust because of income generated through the delivery of the TEACCH training therefore it is cost neutral to South Eastern Health & Social Care Trust.
