I can confirm that the information requested is held by the Department for Communities and Local Government and we are able to provide you with all this information. I have detailed below the information that is being released to you.

2015-16 - £181,982

DCLG gave the Community Security Trust £1million in 2014/15 to enhance the physical security of around 200 Jewish locations across the UK. This formed part of a £11.9 million grant from Government for security of Jewish schools, vulnerable synagogues and communal buildings.
