Thank you for your email which was received by Borders College on 22 October 2020, requesting information about:

Details of numbers of FTE posts furloughed during the qualifying furlough period including details of the following:

- (1) A breakdown of FTE numbers for support staff, teaching staff and senior staff.
- (2) Details of how much revenue was generated from the furlough exercise by category - support staff, teaching staff and senior staff.

Borders College Response

The information you requested is provided below.

- (1) 30.3 FTE support staff and 11.25 teaching staff were furloughed during the period but not for the whole period
- (2) Claims for £75,981.89 for teaching staff and £182,022.13 for support staff have been made to date
