Request for Information

Thank you for your recent email, which requested information in pursuance of the Freedom of Information Act. For clarification, you requested the following information:

Details of grants made to Family Mosaic for development of Parmiter Industrial estate (London E2) - the amount of the grant, the terms of the grant including timescales for completion and build specification, and the circumstances under which the grant would have to be repaid

We have now had the opportunity to investigate your Request, and are writing to communicate our response.

We can confirm that Family Mosaic received a total grant allocation of £8,388,000 in 2008. This funding was provided under the standard National Affordable Homes Programme (NAHP) terms, which set out the circumstances under which the grant would have to be repaid.
