Freedom of information request: HAARP Installations In UK

Thank you for your email, dated 5th April 2014, where you requested the following information:

I request full details of the number of Tesla HAARP installations around Britain and their supposed use.

In America these are built to interfere with the weather patterns, is this the use these installations are put to?

Who in what government authorized their building and use of them?

Who's department is now controlling them?

Who is the head of that department?

Are you aware these installations interfere with the weather so much they cause flooding?

Your request has been considered under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 (EIRs) as the information you have sought disclosure of does, in our view, fall within the definition of 'environmental information' as stated in the EIRs.

Under the EIRs you have the right to:

- · know whether we hold the information you require
- be provided with that information (subject to any exceptions under the Regulations which may apply).

I am writing to advise you that, following a search of our paper and electronic records, I have established that the information you requested is not held by this Department.



Appeals Procedure

If you are dissatisfied with the handling of your request, you have the right to ask for an internal review. Internal review requests should be submitted within 40 working days of the date of receipt of the response to your original letter and should be sent to the Information Rights Unit at:
